AgriTech or agricultural technology is the technology used in improving yield, efficiency, and profitability in agriculture. The various segments of AgriTech sector are digital marketplace and physical infrastructure to link farmers to information platforms for agronomic, pricing, market information, automation using machinery, tools and robots in seeding, material handling, harvesting, credit facilities for input procurement, equipment, etc. Technological aid to the farmers can also be provided by informing them on the latest developments on plant and animal life sciences and genomics, farming technologies, such as greenhouse systems, indoor-outdoor farming, drip irrigation, and environmental control. Digitally monitoring post-harvest products, quality check and analysis and traceability in storage and transportation along with support towards handling post-harvest supply chain and connecting farm output with the customers are major service the recent developments in internet technologies can offer. Use of geospatial or weather data, IOT, sensors, robotics etc also improves productivity to a great extent. Benefits of technological developments cover financial benefits to farmer like farm equipment for rent on a pay-per-use basis, as well as insurance or reinsurance of crop etc.

The COVID 19 pandemic and the war in Ukraine have massively disrupted the global food system, putting huge pressure on agriculture-focused countries like India to provide more sustainable options. Such investment can also have a significant impact beyond the economy. With 60 per cent of India's agricultural land being rain-fed, climate change poses a critical threat to food and agricultural systems. Many states have already taken up technology aided agriculture as an essential project. The E-Sahamathi initiative of Karnataka enables the sharing of agriculture and horticulture data from its database of more than 7 million farmers with start-ups/service providers and Telangana is working towards establishing agriculture data exchange ADEX. Access to digital financing and insurance services for hugely underserved smallholding and women farmers needs data from digitized land records, crop-cutting experiments, satellite images, fertilizer consumption and crop history. In order to cater this, the World Economic Forum has launched the AI4AI (AI for Agriculture Innovation) initiative and food innovation hubs in collaboration with the Agriculture Ministry and multiple State Governments. Some states including Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya and Karnataka have also been exploring various private-public partnership (PPP) approaches for hi-tech agriculture services. Madhya Pradesh has launched a Food Innovation Hub to explore PPP models for crop value chain transformation, while Meghalaya has been examining how to leverage technologies to transform the turmeric value chain.

Overall, the AgriTech companies accepted the challenges thrown by the pandemic and have been able to create need fulfilling technological products and services which has resulted in evolutionary opportunities for suddenly-open-to-tech Indian farmers. The Indian agriculture sector has, therefore, moved a step ahead to adopt and gain the most out of the challenging times.

A regional conclave has already been organized under the aegis of All India Students Committee on this topic. As a Chairman, All India Students Committee, I would request you to explore this emerging field as it poses immense opportunities for the young engineers.



# Steps to establish IEI Students' Chapters in Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics

Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics may establish Students' Chapter of IEI with atleast fifty students pursuing engineering in the same branch of a College/University/Institution and be a part of the IEI fraternity following steps below:

- Initial request from an engineering college/a polytechnic is to be made to the Director (Membership) of IEI expressing desire to open a Students' Chapter at the Engineering College/Polytechnic mentioning the branches of engineering.
- (i) In a College/University/Institution, at least **fifty numbers (50)** of students irrespective of the year of study in the same branch of engineering is required for opening a Students' Chapter.
- (ii) To enable formation of a Chapter in any recognized polytechnic minimum number of member required is **fifty (50)**. There shall be only one Chapter in a polytechnic.

This strength of membership shall be mandatory for opening as also for continuing a Students Chapter. However, it's requested to motivate all the students to enroll themselves in the chapter.

- Upon obtaining the permission and code of the new Students' Chapter from IEI, prospective Chapters have to download the forms [for engineering college Students' Members (ECSC) and Polytechnic Students' Member (PSC)] from the webpage [www.ieindia.org](http://www.ieindia.org). The forms have to be filled up by the students willing for members of Students' Chapter in consultation with the Adviser.
