Preamble

The Institution of Engineers (India) [IEI] over the past 100 years has established its rich legacy towards the cause of promotion and advancement of the science, practice and business of Engineering through a multitude of activities. The number of academic institutions offering a degree or equivalent program in engineering/ technology has grown up significantly over the last few years. There is a need to identify the leading Engineering Educational Institutions for others to provide better and effective engineering education to the seekers. In view of the above, it has been decided to institute '**Engineering Education Excellence Award 2025**' with the prime objective of recognizing the best Educational Institutions in the field of engineering & technology across the country. The award will be given away during the 40th Indian Engineering Congress.

Role of The Institution of Engineers (India)

IEI has been playing a critical role in defining excellence and setting up benchmarks for upliftment of engineering education. The Department of Scientific & Industrial Research, Ministry of Science & Technology, Govt. of India has recognized it as a Scientific & Industrial Research Organization (SIRO) by virtue of its contribution in the area of scientific and industrial research. IEI was the only Accreditation Body in the country before the formation of AICTE in 1987 and NBA in 1994 and hence it is strategically positioned in developing and establishing the standards which would serve as a sieve for filtering out the best educational Institutions in engineering & technology.

Categories of the Award

With a view to promote the Engineering Education, award would be given under the following categories:

Category-A : Engineering Education Excellence Award - Engineering College / Institution

Category-B : Engineering Education Excellence Award - Polytechnic (including Women)

Category-C : Engineering Education Excellence Award - Women Engineering Institution / College

Assessment Process

The assessment of the applications will be carried out at two levels as follows:-

Level-I: The first level of assessment would be carried out by a committee based on the weightage given to different items in the application proforma. The shortlisted applications will then be selected and presented to the Jury/Award Committee.

Level-II: The second and final level of assessment would be carried out by the Jury Board/Award Committee. the decision of the Jury/Committee would be communicated to the selected Awards winners. The decision of the Jury shall be final and binding.

Essence of Award

The main purpose of instituting the Awards is:-

- Gain recognition and celebrate hard work and achievements of the Institutions/Universities
- Boost up the morale of workplace of Institutes/University and encourage further innovations
- Sharing the best practices and learn from others
- Grow the academic & research network with other stakeholders



